1. Identify the exact time and location.
2. Take photos or video of what you are seeing.

### AT HOME OR AT WORK -- DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR

- 1 ASK ICE TO SLIDE A WARRANT UNDER THE DOOR.**  
The warrant must be signed by a judge and must also have your name and address.  
**WITHOUT THIS WARRANT, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT NOT TO OPEN THE DOOR TO YOUR HOME OR BUSINESS.**



- 2 ASK FOR A LAWYER, THEN REMAIN SILENT. DO NOT** answer any questions or sign any documents without speaking to a lawyer.
- 3 DOCUMENT**  
You have the right to record ICE. Especially if you are a US citizen, document bravely. Video the agents, and take down badge numbers and names. **CALL DIRE HOTLINE!**

### IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD -- ASK: AM I FREE TO GO?

- 1** It is unconstitutional for ICE to detain you without a reasonable suspicion or a warrant signed by a judge.  
If ICE says you are free to leave, LEAVE. You are not required to show ID. If you are a citizen, you can stand in solidarity by refusing to show ID and keeping the focus on yourself.
- 2 DO NOT CARRY OR PROVIDE FAKE ID.** Do not carry ID from your county of birth. Carry local ID and proof you've been here as long as possible (like a lease or electric bill). If ICE says you are not free to leave and detains you, remain calm and do not resist.
- 3 DO NOT SPEAK OR SIGN ANYTHING WITHOUT A LAWYER.**  
**SAY "I DO NOT CONSENT TO THIS SEARCH" IF ICE ATTEMPTS TO SEARCH YOU.**
- 4 DOCUMENT**  
You have the right to record ICE agents. Video ICE agents and LOUDLY announce ICE IS HERE! Tell the person being detained not to speak or sing anything without a lawyer.

### MAKE A PLAN

- Memorize numbers of lawyers and emergency contacts, make emergency plans for medical and childcare, and prepare important documents. Connect with trusted neighbors.
- Get to know your neighbors and local organizations. In NJ, we are but one of many groups building power in the community & fighting back against deportations and detention centers.

CUT OFF AND KEEP BY YOUR FRONT DOOR

**Officer: I do not wish to speak with you, answer your questions, or sign or hand you any documents based on my 5th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution. I do not give you permission to enter my home based on my 4th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution unless you have a warrant to enter, signed by a judge or magistrate with my name on it that you can slide under the door. I do not give you permission to search any of my belongings based on my 4th amendment rights.**
