You may have heard about a spontaneous protest that occurred two Fridays back in Lindenwold. About 300 people turned out to show support for the immigrant community and to protest ICE, and the early rumor on social media was the event was organized quickly after the horrific video from the morning before of 5th and 6th graders running from their bus stop because ICE agents rolled up.

As horrific as that video was, and as inspiring as the protest the next evening was, there is more to this story, and it is partly a story about how Cooper River Indivisible supports communities throughout our region, and how we support people like you when you decide it is time to step up. It is also a story that highlights what fascism looks like on the ground, and why the next No Kings event on March 28th is more vital than ever.

About No Kings 3 - Cooper River Indivisible is planning our biggest demonstration of solidarity in our 8-year history, and it is going to be epic! We will gather at Camden City Hall at 11:00am, and then march through downtown to Wiggins Waterfront Park for a righteous rally. We are partnering with many different grassroots organizations in the area who will be there to provide information on their specific work and how to get more involved. There will be music, food trucks, giant puppets . . . all in the context of a joyous afternoon surrounded by 1000s of like-minded friends.
