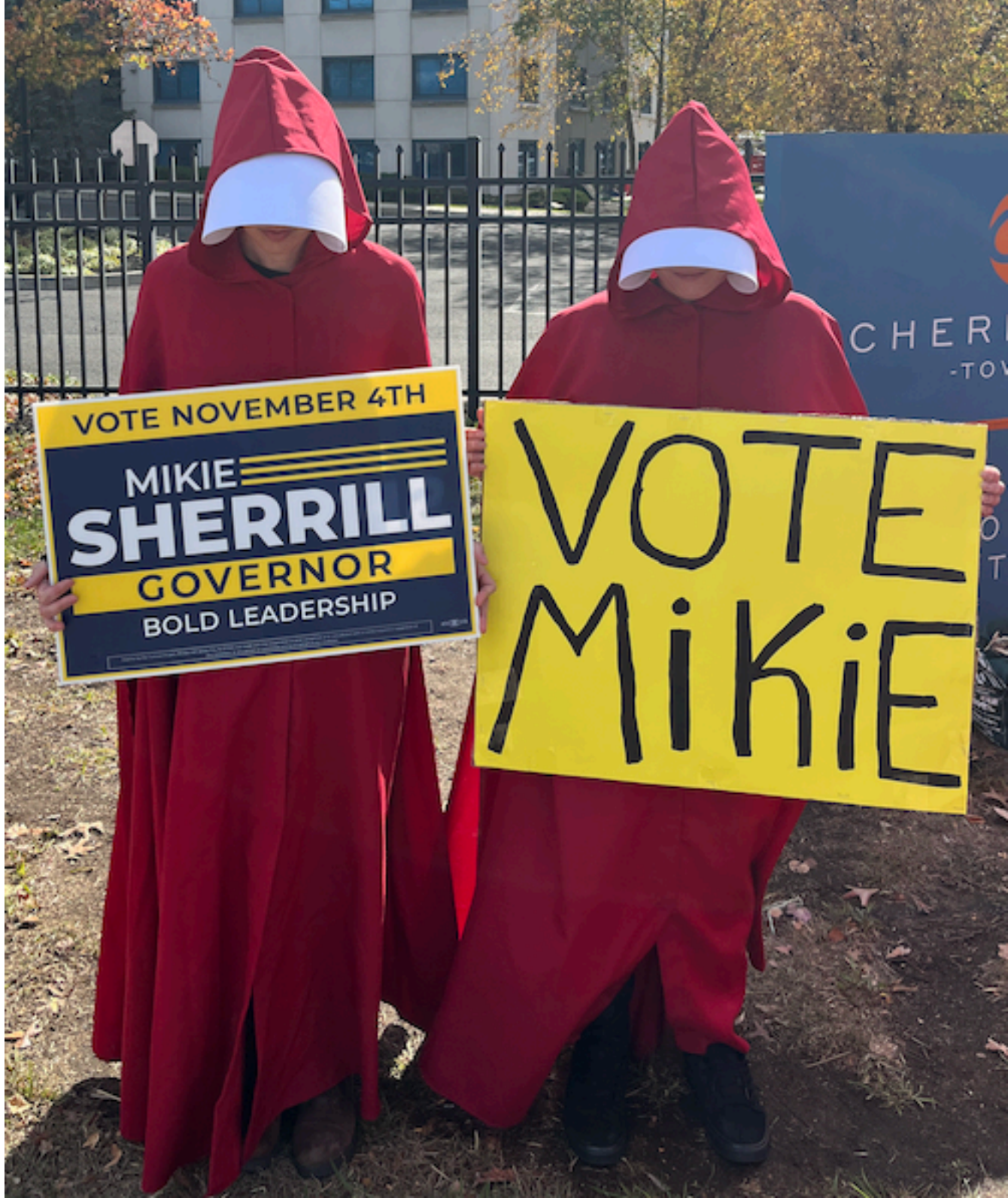


COOPER RIVER INDIVISIBLE

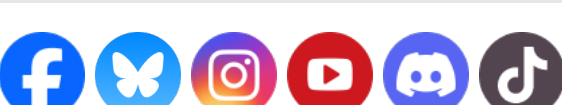
