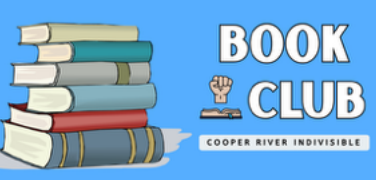

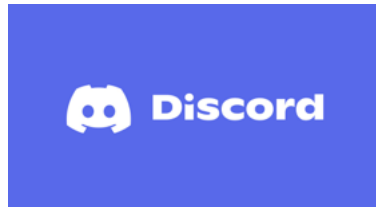


## Kick In Some Funds
